

DECLARATION TO ENTRY IN ITALY

In order to counter the spread of the epidemiological emergency from COVID-19, with the Decrees of the Minister of Infrastructure and Transport, adopted together with the Minister of Health, of 17 March 2020, n.120 and 18 March 2020, n .122, it has been established that:

➤ All natural persons entering Italy, by air, railways, sea and road transport, even if asymptomatic, are obliged to communicate immediately their entry in Italy to the competent Department of prevention of health insurance in the territory, and are subjected to health surveillance and fiduciary isolation for a period of fourteen (14) days. In the event of the onset of COVID-19 symptoms, they are obliged to report promptly the situation to the Health Authority through the dedicated telephone numbers.

➤ In opposite of the previous point, only for their proving working needs and for a period not more than 72 hours - except for a reason of extension for specific needs of an additional 48 hours - natural persons entering Italy, by air, railways, sea and road are required to present a declaration, made pursuant to articles 46 and 47 of the decree of the President of the Republic December 28 2000, n. 445, in which they certify that they enter just for working needs. With this declaration, it is also assumed the obligation, in the case of the onset of COVID-19 symptoms, to report promptly this situation to the responsible Department of prevention of health insurance for the territory through the dedicated telephone numbers, and be in isolation until the decision of the Health Authority;

➤ These measures is not applicated for:

a) to medical staff entering in Italy for exercise their professional healthcare qualifications, including the temporary work referred to art. 13 of the decree-law of 17 March 2020, n.18.

b) to cross-border workers entering and leaving the national territory for proven work reasons and for return to their residence or home, in compliance with the provisions established by art. 1, letter a of the D.P.C.M. of March 8, 2020 subsequently extended within the national territory by the D.P.C.M. March 9, 2020.

➤ **To be aware of the penalties provided by art.3, paragraph 4, of Legislative Decree of February 23, 2020, n. 6 and art. 4, paragraph 1, of the D.P:C:M of 8 March 2020 in case of non-compliance with the aforementioned containment measures** (art. 650) if the fact doesn't constitute a serious crime).

- Proven working needs.
- Situations of necessity.
- Health reasons;
- Return to my home or residence.
